Good day to all of you,

Hi, hello you there. It is a pleasure to receive your mail. So far you have a very beautiful and huge school and thanks for the photo. Thank you for giving me your school particulars and info of your school, really nice to hear on it.

Presently we are in Oran, Algeria and we are discharging “Soyabeans” of 32,000mt about. We had loaded the cargo from Baie Comeau Canada last end November 2020. We cross the Atlantic Ocean to bring the cargo safely and economically which means always tried to be away from severe weather and calculate the shortest and safest distance to navigate in order to minimize fuel consumption. Less consumption of fuel also means saving the planet earth. We also encountered bad weather but always manageable to navigate. From the present time we always stay onboard as much that we could do in order to maintained measures and pre-cautions of anti COVID19.

My vessel’s running speed is 14 knots at sea passage. 1 knot is equal 1852meters and therefore my ship’s is running 25,928meters every one(1) hour and with a total distance 622,928meters in 24 hours. My vessel’s length is 180.4meters and Breadth of 30.0m and Moulded depth of 14.4meters. She can load with a total deadweights of 34,175mt with summer draft of 9.916m. Deadweight means the total weight which she could load like fuel oils, crew, stores, provisions, ballast water, fresh water and specially her cargo. My vessel is manned in accordance with flag state approval which comprise of Captain / Master with his deck department Chief mate, 2nd mate, 3rd mate, Bosun, Able seaman, Ordinary seaman, deck cadet, also with his Engine department Chief engr, 2nd engr., 3rd engr., electrical engineer, wiper, engine cadet and of course the most very important is the department who is preparing our food is the Catering department. All of this crew/persons onboard have different task and each individual had a vital functions onboard.
